What is iWAT'2010?

iWAT - International Workshop on Antenna Technology, is one of the most important world conferences on antenna technology innovation, which has venues in the three geographical world areas: America, Asia/Pacific, and Europe. Previous editions took place in Singapore, White Plains (NY, EUA), Cambridge (UK), Chiba (Japan) and Santa Monica (CA, EUA). The next edition, **iWAT'2010**, www.iwat2010.it.pt, will be held in Lisbon, Portugal, on March 1-3.

How is iWAT organised?

iWAT is the result of a joint collaboration between academia and active industrial players in the antenna field. Further to the Organising Committee (OC), **iWAT** includes an International Advisory Committee (IAC), and a Technical Program Committee (TPC), which are chaired in the 2010 edition by:

- ◆ OC General Chair: Prof. António Alves Moreira (IT/IST, Portugal).
- ◆ IAC Co-Chairs: Prof. Raj Mittra (Penn. State Univ., PA, EUA); Prof. Zhi Ning Chen (Institute for Infocomm Research, Singapore); Prof. Custódio Peixeiro (IT/IST, Portugal).
- ◆ TPC Co-Chairs: Prof. Carlos Fernandes (IT/IST, Portugal); Prof. Yi Huang (Univ. Liverpool, UK)

IAC and TPC are formed by around 40 members each, amidst the major world specialists in the field (further information available at www.iwat2010.it.pt).

Which is iWAT's structure?

iWAT is structured into Technical Sessions with keynote speakers, and oral presentations covering the latest developments in the antenna technology field. **iWAT** also includes poster presentations, and an Industry Panel with invitees from Europe, America and Asia/Pacific. There is also an Exhibition Area.

The conference is usually attended by around 150 participants, coming from about 25 countries over the world.
